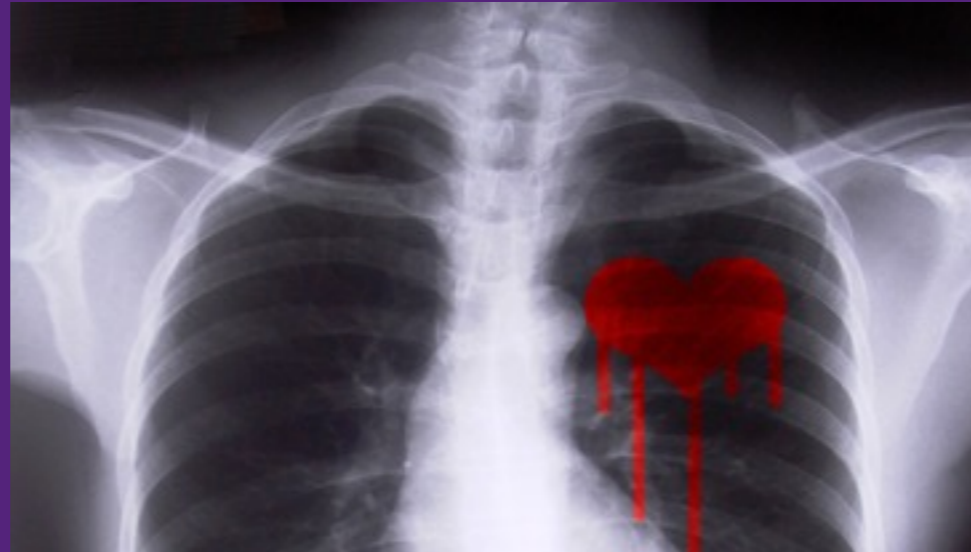

2 Timothy 4:9-16 (NKJV)

⁹ Be diligent to come to me quickly; ¹⁰ for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and has departed for Thessalonica—Crescens for Galatia, Titus for Dalmatia. ¹¹ Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful to me for ministry. ¹² And Tychicus I have sent to Ephesus.



2 Timothy 4:9-16 (NKJV)

¹³ Bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas when you come—and the books, especially the parchments. ¹⁴ Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm. May the Lord repay him according to his works. ¹⁵ You also must beware of him, for he has greatly resisted our words. ¹⁶ At my first defense no one stood with me, but all forsook me. May it not be charged against them.



I. How To Handle Being DUMPED

¹⁰ for Demas has forsaken me, having loved this present world, and has departed for Thessalonica

—...

- a. Don't blame yourself!
- b. When people dump you, they love something more than you
- c. They have another plan in mind



II. How To Handle Being DAMAGED

¹⁴ Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm. May the Lord repay him according to his works. ¹⁵ You also must beware of him, for he has greatly resisted our words.



- a. Your damage isn't self-inflicted
- b. You will be defended
- c. Your damagers are dangerous



III. How To Handle Being DESERTED

¹⁶ At my first defense no one stood with me, but all forsook me. May it not be charged against them.



- a. Desertion isn't a trust issue, it's a defense!
- b. There are moments you'll have to stand alone
- c. Forgiveness Isn't Optional
